






## 140' x 38' Crabber

The *Pinnacle* is a single-chine, steel-hulled Bering Sea power-scow with house and engine room aft. Fuel is carried in wing tanks outboard of the three RSW holds. A large dry hold is positioned forward of the RSW holds. The bait freezer and two large storage rooms are positioned in the foc'sle. The engine room has three generators - two 300-KW sets for normal ship loads and a smaller 105-KW set for harbor loads. Deck machinery includes the standard outfit for a pot fishing vessel, with hauling davit and pot launcher forward and two cranes. Fixed wingwalls on both sides afford protection for the crew. The crew accommodations are located aft on the main and boat decks aft, with the Captain's stateroom positioned behind the wheelhouse. A large galley and mess area provide a comfortable gathering place for the crew.
