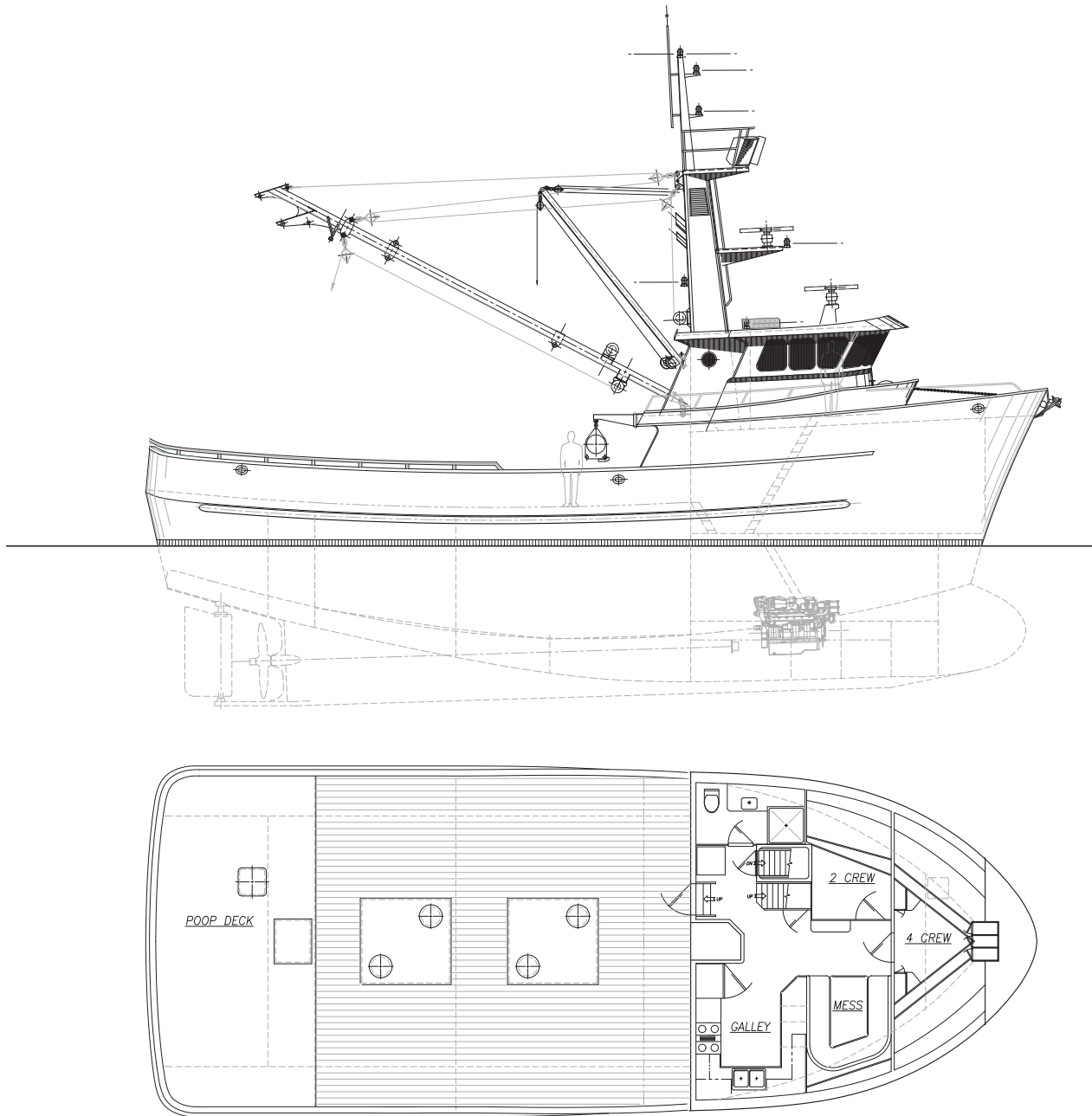

## 72' Combination Fishing Vessel

The *Miss Emily* is a conventional single chine, steel hull fishing vessel with house and engine room forward. The single-chine hull is designed with an integral bulbous bow using a single developable surface for easier and less costly construction. The vessel is equipped with two large fish holds and a bait hold aft. Fuel is carried in wing and double bottom tanks. The engine room has three generators, a 60KW set and a 100KW set for normal ship loads, and a smaller 25kW set for harbor loads. The boat can be configured for shrimping, crabbing, seining and tendering. The mess, galley and crew accommodations are located forward on the main deck, with the Captain's stateroom behind the wheelhouse.
